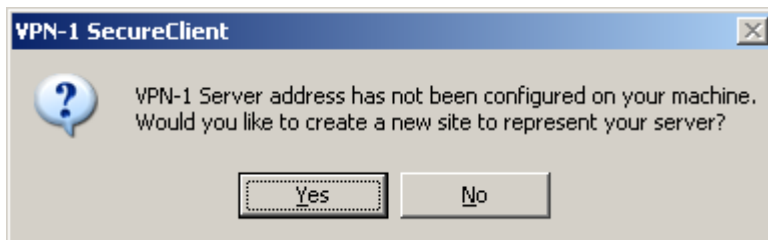


Setting up the VPN


Double click on the key.



Click Yes.




Type "vpn.wilsonhtm.com.au" into the Server Address box.







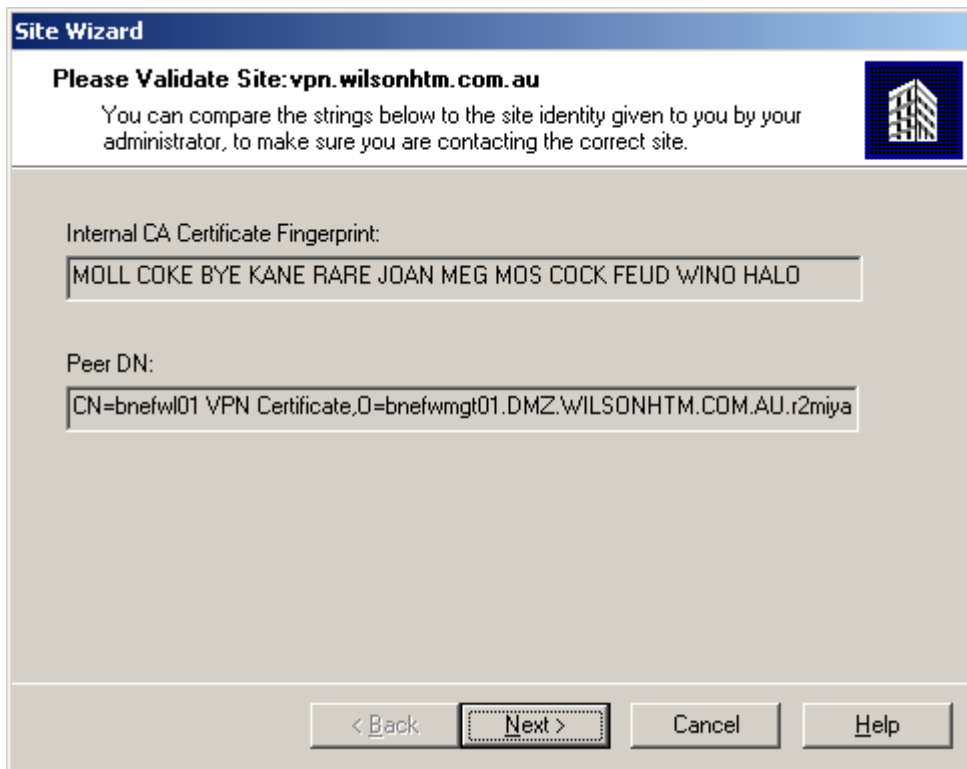
Enter your Windows username and password, there is no need to prefix with PROD. Click *Next*.



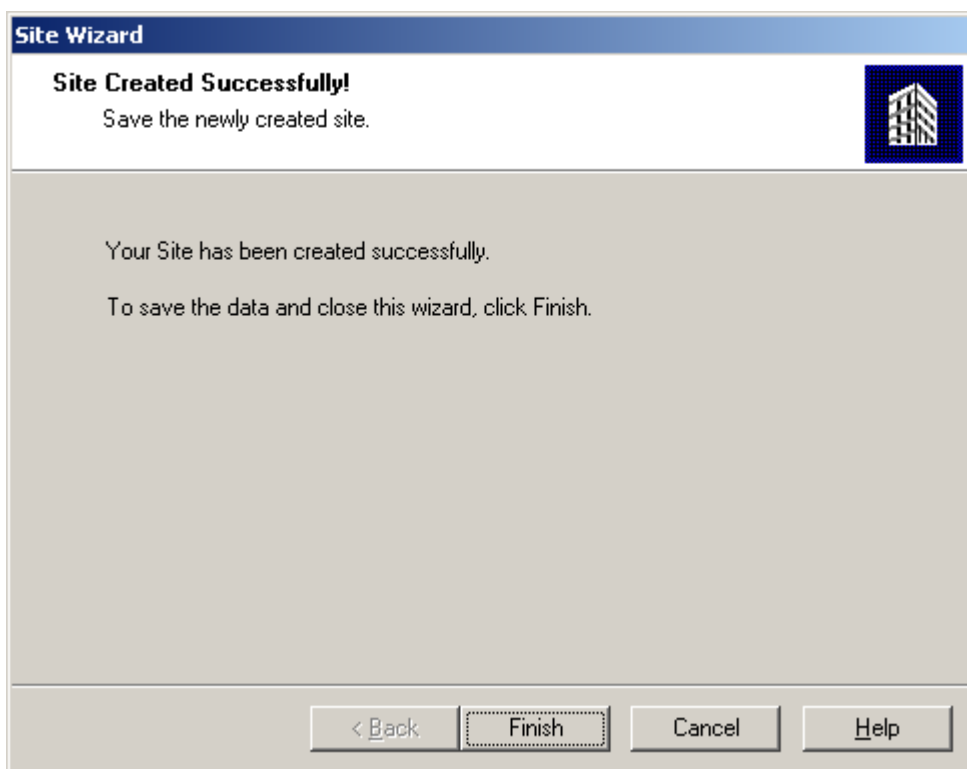

Click *Next*.



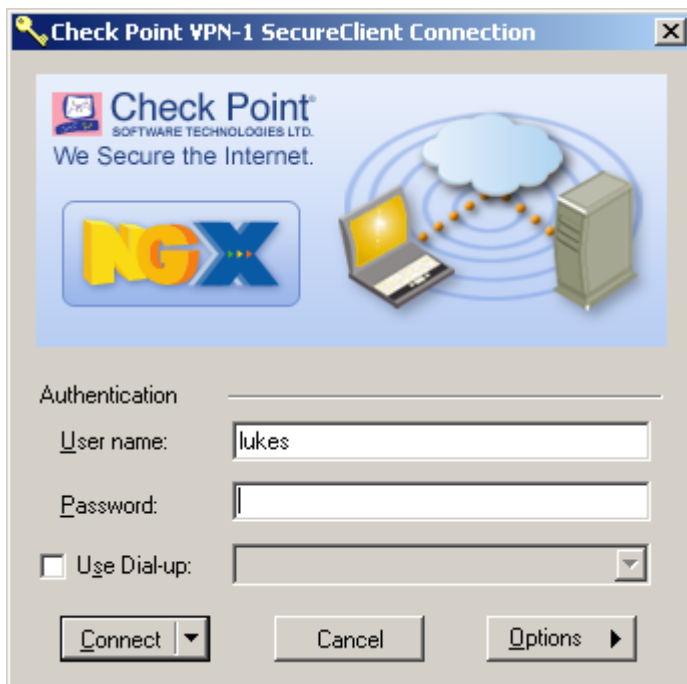
Click *Finish*.



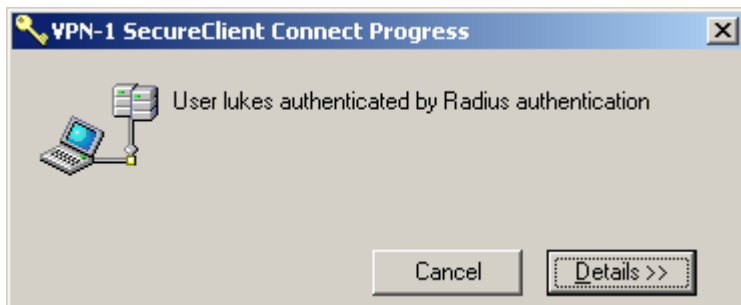
You will then be asked to connect. Please do.

Connecting the VPN

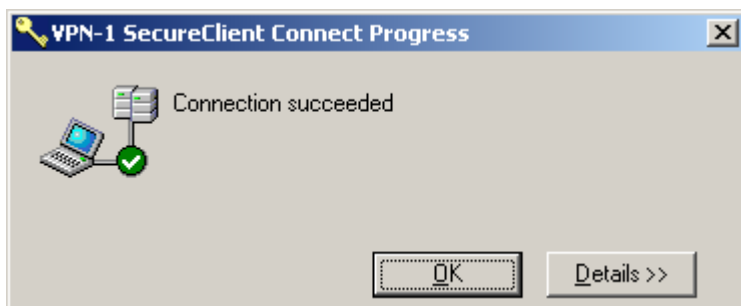
Normally you click on the Key to get this box to pop up-
